ther than "Christmastime is Here" by Vince Guaraldi, few songs make me as happy at this time of year than one that we typically reserve for our Christmas Eve Candlelight Service: "O, Holy Night."

It was first composed in French as "Le Cantique de Noël." In this month of Advent and Christmas to come, I feel its words reveal so much theological importance about what it is that we hold as Christians to speak about our faith (not to mention it being simply a beautiful tune). Yet many of us may not be familiar with its original, perhaps even more profound message.

I would like to offer a literal translation of the original poem from which our beloved hymn comes, which says more in English says more than ever I could. May these verses give you joy as we approach this most solemn and holy night, and may their truth be yours every day of this month and life ahead:

May we kneel to, bow before, and sing forever of Christ,

May the ardent light of our Faith guide us all to the cradle of the infant, as in ancient times a brilliant star guided the Oriental kings there. The King of Kings was born in a humble manger; O mighty ones of today, proud of your greatness, it is to your pride that God preaches.

Bow your heads before the Redeemer! Bow your heads before the Redeemer! The Redeemer has broken every bond:

The Earth is free, and Heaven is open. He sees a brother where there was only a slave, Love unites those that iron had chained. who will tell Him of our gratitude, For all of us He is born, He suffers and dies.

People stand up! Sing of your deliverance, Christmas, Christmas, sing of the Redeemer, Christmas, Christmas, sing of the Redeemer!
